Scholarship established in 2020 by a bequest from Beverly Claus Dismukes to honor her affection for music and for the North Platte region. Dr. Fred Wanek (1940-2020) was born and raised in North Platte. She graduated from Hastings College with a Bachelor of Arts in music and continued her music education at University of Nebraska-Lincoln and University of Nebraska at Kearney. She taught music to students in the North Platte Public Schools from 1964 to 2000. She also shared her love of music by teaching piano lessons to generations of young people in the North Platte area. This scholarship is administered by Mid-Nebraska Community Foundation.

Who may apply?

- 1) Student who is or will be a full-time music major who demonstrates musical talent.
- 2) Home residence must be in one of the Nebraska counties of Custer, Dawson, Frontier, Hayes, Hooker, Keith, Lincoln, Logan, McPherson, Perkins or Thomas.
- 3) Applicants must demonstrate financial need.
- 4) Scholarships may be renewed upon re-application and selection from among all applicants.

Where can scholarship be used? At any accredited two or four-year U.S. college or university.

Number of scholarships and amount? One scholarship of \$2,700 will be awarded for the coming school year.

- 2) A one-page Resume listing such things as academic awards, student activities and clubs, athletics, other organization memberships, hobbies, volunteer experiences, military service and employment.
- 3) A Personal Statement about yourself that may include such topics as your goals, interests, meaningful activities, career plans, why you should be considered for this scholarship, and how you plan to finance college education. (No more than 2 pages, double-spaced).
- 4) One recent letter of recommendation from someone familiar with applicant's musical talent.
- 5) FAFSA Student Aid Report with Estimated Family Contribution.

Complete application must be delivered or postmarked by March 3, 2021.
