Sokol, recognize Nebraska high school seniors who exemplify perseverance and selflessness in facing unusual challenges, who are leaders in their communities and who seem destined for success.

This year, we are awarding fifteen \$10,000 scholarships.

- Ten D.J.'s Hero Scholarships

- One Creighton University Athletic Department Scholarship (selected by Creighton University leadership)

Attendance is strongly encouraged for all award winners and The Salvation Army will provide travel and housing stipends for those who need to travel. 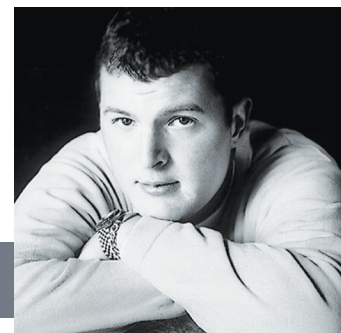

D.J. is remembered for his passion for life, his engaging sense of humor and his selfless focus on family, friends and community. His legacy lives on in the scholarship recipients who demonstrate his resilience and generosity.

ABOUT THE AWARDS

Ten **\$10,000 D.J.'s Hero Scholarships** are underwritten by David and Peggy Sokol in loving memory of their son, D.J. The awards recognize Nebraska high school seniors who exemplify perseverance and selflessness and who are servant-leaders in their communities.

The **\$10,000 D.J.'s Hero Teresa Hunzeker Memorial Scholarship** recognizes a student who demonstrates perseverance and service to the community, and who plans to pursue STEM (science, technology, engineering or math) studies in college. The scholarship honors the life of Teresa Hunzeker, who passed away in 2018.

The **\$10,000 D.J.'s Hero Diesing Family North High Scholarship** is underwritten by Terri and Jack Diesing and will be awarded to a senior at Omaha's North High School - Mrs. Diesing's alma mater.

The **\$10,000 D.J.'s Hero Creighton University Athletic Department Scholarship**, will award \$2,500 annually (up to four years) to a student attending Creighton University. Recipients will be selected by Creighton University and have an interest in an intercollegiate athletics-related field.



A minimum of two **\$10,000 D.J.'s Hero Scholarships** will be funded by The Salvation Army.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES

ELIGIBILITY

For Nominee:

1. Must be enrolled as a senior at or affiliated with a Nebraska high school during the 2020-2021 academic year and be planning to attend college in the U.S. in fall 2021.
2. Agrees to attend D.J.'s Hero Awards Luncheon in Omaha (stipend for transportation and lodging will be provided to non-Omaha residents).
3. Must agree to work with a free TeamMates+ mentor during their undergraduate experience and participate in ongoing research about the impact of the scholarship.

For Nominator:

1. Must be an adult (age 21 or older).
2. Must not be related to nominee.
3. Should have direct connection with nominee (e.g. teacher, counselor, coach, administrator, pastor, mentor, employer, leader of community organization).

Nominators may nominate more than one student.

- The decision of the Selection Committee is final.

NOMINATION PROCESS

For Nominee:

1. Sign and have responsible adult sign Nomination Form.
2. Write Nominee Statement (12-pt. type, 250 words or fewer) addressing the following two questions:
 - a. What are your short- and long-range plans and goals?
 - b. How will being awarded a D.J.'s Hero Scholarship help you achieve these goals?

For Nominator:

1. Complete and sign enclosed Nomination Form (forms can also be downloaded from salarmyomaha.org)
2. Write Nominator Statement addressing the following five questions (12-pt. type, two single-spaced pages or fewer):
 - a. What adversity has the nominee overcome?
 - b. How has the nominee demonstrated a positive attitude, a commitment to others, leadership and/or service to his/her community?
 - c. What are the nominee's greatest achievements?
 - d. What school or community activities has the nominee participated in?
 - e. What is the nominee's financial need?
3. Submit Nomination Form, Nominee Statement and Nominator Statement.
