Title of Award: Custer County Post 3576, Veterans of Foreign Wars Scholarship

Area, Field or Subject: Trade, Technical, Business, College or University

Level of Education: Will be granted to graduating high school senior or of an accredited school planning to attend a school of higher learning.

Number and Amount: Post 3576 will determine the number and amount of scholarships to be awarded each year. The number and amounts may vary annually.

Method of Disbursement: Payment will be made to the applicant and institution after they certify that the student has enrolled in the second semester of their freshmen year.

Qualifications: Must be a child of grandchild of a current member or member of Post 3576 at the time of his death. We may require verification by birth certificate if necessary. The student must have demonstrated ability and aptitude for secondary education. The student must submit a written essay of 50 words or more stating his or her educational goals. A recent photo may be required for publicity purposes.

Application Date: March 1st of each year
